# FESTIVAL FEVER CHALLENGES

As with all our other campovers, Festival Fever has a flexible over-arching theme

**‘Sleep somewhere other than your own bed and take part in a campover activity’**

Below you’ll find some festival themed challenges for you to use either before or during the event as it suits you. Remember that its all really flexible for girls to be able to

## **CHALLENGE #1—Set up your Festival Site**

Make yourself somewhere to sleep during the event

Will you be booking into ‘comfort plus’, ‘glamping’ or ‘family camping’? Make sure that you send us pictures (with full permissions) of your festival sites.

Make sure you can carry all of your gear to your festival site and get it all put away afterwards.

Does your festival site need signposts or decorations?

## **CHALLENGE #2—Get Festival ready!**

Have a go at painting your own face or someone elses.

Face painting can be anything from a full character face to more subtle patterns on your cheeks or arms

You’ll also find some inspiration online - check out Snazaroo’s website for all sorts of handy hints and tips

Make yourself a festival wristband or lanyard - access all areas!

## **CHALLENGE #3—Festival Food!**

Lots of festivals are renowned for the selection of food that they serve.

Have a go at making yourself a ‘street food’ meal, served up to eat as you would buy it at a festival.

Street Food is food purchased to be eaten immediately in a street, public location or in this case at a festival - types of street food can include Burgers, Hot Dogs, Nachos, Paella, Pizza, Pasta, Noodles and lots of yummy desserts such as Churros, Waffles, Donuts and Ice Cream.

Make sure that you can cater for everyone's dietary requirements and that you wash up afterwards!

#### **CHALLENGE #4—Enjoy Yourself!**

Dance and sing like no one's watching!

Download yourself a play list of your favourite tunes and make up your dream Festival line up.

Watch our talent showcase and join in with all the fun.

#### **CHALLENGE #5—Be Green!**

Many festival organisers are very conscious about the carbon footprint of their festival and are working all the time on how this can be reduced.

Food miles - try and source locally produced food or keep a track of things you are buying and try and swap them for a more local alternative.

Green transport - challenge yourself to travel environmentally friendly during the event - you could walk, ride a bike or use public transport.

Single use plastics - Try and use alternatives to single use plastics (eg a refillable drink bottle or hot drink cup) and recycle as much rubbish as possible.

Litter - make sure that you litter pick your festival site and if you're going out over the weekend you could set yourself a litter picking target.

#### **CHALLENGE #6— Your Dream Festival**

What would your dream festival be like? What would you call it? Where would it be held? Would it have all music or some other acts such as poetry, drama or comedy?

Design your Festival site, draw a map with all your amenities or make a 3D model using toys such as lego or junk modelling using recycled items.



## **DON'T BE SHY!**

There are no auditions and everything that is submitted will be included in some way.

Its open to all members including leaders, individuals or groups. Why not send in some socially distanced performances if you are starting to meet face to face.
