

Girlguiding Derbyshire Grant Requests

Grants are available to individual Girlguiding members and units within Derbyshire.

Grants can be for:

- Recruitment & Training This grant can be applied to any opportunity directly related to the recruitment of girls and/or adults. This grant can also be applied to any training undertaken by a member of Girlguiding Derbyshire which is directly related to improving the guiding experience of the leaders themselves, their unit leadership team and/or girls.
- **Opportunities** The purpose of this fund is to support any guiding related opportunities for girls and/or leaders. This includes, but is not limited to:-
 - support to attend County/Region/National events and trips
 - support to buy equipment needed for unit guiding/residentials/leadership activities for members of Girlguiding Derbyshire
- International trips for members attending Girlguiding international trips or for units arranging overseas trips. Note – members selected for Region / County trips do not need to complete this form but should write in to the office to request the standard grant.

Applications should be completed in full. Please supplement the application form with additional information and attach a copy of the event/activity flyer or publicity material where appropriate.

Applications by / on behalf of Girlguiding members under 18 should be accompanied by an additional form completed by their Area / District Commissioner / Unit leader (see part 2).

Applications for international trips should include part 3.

All applications submitted will be fully assessed at the next Finance and General Purposes Committee which occur at regular intervals throughout the year. Applicants may be contacted during the meeting to answer questions relating to their request and will be advised in advance if they need to be available.

Note Retrospective grant applications will not normally be considered.
